

# Remarks On Board Ship Comulgee

Thursday Feb 14<sup>th</sup> 1835

First part Light winds from the S.W. and squally heading N.E. Mid & Latter part Light breeze from the S.W. and squally with rain S.E.

Log 10.28.0

Friday Feb 15<sup>th</sup>

First part Light southerly winds and fine weather heading to the N.W. Mid & Latter part Light breeze from the South during A.M. & with all sail out to sea

Saturday 16

First part Light breeze from the North and fine weather heading to the N.E. Mid & Latter moderate at 7 saw a school of Fin whale breaved and got a large whale at 12 took him to the Ship's Puns

Log 8.30

Sunday 17

First part Light fresh breeze and squally with fresh rain at 2 P.M. commenced cutting got the head mast off and laid by for the night Mid & Latter moderate gale and ruffed at 8 A.M. commenced cutting at 12 A.M. got the head off

To sea

Monday 18

First part moderate at 4 P.M. got through cutting the badly parted from the head toward a boat and took it along side again and it parted again in waving ship. Lost it Mid & Latter fresh breeze and fine weather Ship half the night on one tack and half on the other under short sail at daylight made sail and started the works to sea

First part Light air from the S.E. and fine weather heading N.E. & S. with all sail got through towing heading N.E. Mid & Latter part wind from W to S.W. Ship on different tack squally Soles

First part Light breeze from West and squally heading W.S.W. with all sail out Mid & Latter much the same to sea
