

Remarks On Board Ship Cornucopia

Monday Feb 25th 1835

First part Light Breeze from the N.W. and squally heading N.E. Middle part gentle Breeze and fine weather heading S.W. to S. by E

Lat 6° 39'
Long 116° 33'

Tuesday 26th

First part Light Breeze from the N.W. heading N.E. at 3 P.M. Long Island Baring N past to Sward about 10 miles Middle & Latter moderate and some squally heading N.E. & S.W. to S. by E

Wednesday 27th

First part Light Breeze and squally at 3 P.M. had a squall from the N.E. turning N.W. Middle & Latter parts Light Breeze from the Eastward turning N.W. to S. by E

Lat 5° 09'
Long 116° 31'

Thursday 28th

First part Light Breeze from the Eastward and squally turning N.W. at 4 P.M. the wind shifted in a squall from S.W. Middle part squally Latter part Strong Breeze from N.W. with fresh rain fell the fore top sail we bent it & hauled

Friday March 1st 1835

First part Strong Breeze from West and fresh rain heading N.W. but another fair top sail Middle part Strong Breeze at 12 M. Acast Ship to the Westward. Latter Strong Breeze and some squally heading N.W. to S. by E

Saturday March 1st 1835

First part fresh Breeze from the N.E. and some squally at half past 2 P.M. carried away the Main top gallant Mast with William Wood in the top gallant cross trees pit to him on board. Lured a Boat and put him up and not hurt him much sent down the mast Middle & Latter Strong Breeze and squally with rain sent down the fore top gallant mast and sent it up off and bent the Main top gallant ^{sail} & hauled

Sunday 2nd

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. and squally with rain heading West at 5 P.M. had a squall from the N.W. and fresh rain last Ship to the North Latter fresh Breeze from the N.W. and squally heading West to S. by E

Lat 2° 13' S
Long 111° 33' E

Monday 3rd

First gentle Breeze and some squally heading West at 6 A.M. had a squall from the S.W. back to the North Middle Light Breeze from the N.W. heading N.E. Latter gentle Breeze from N.W. back to the West squally with rain Ship with courses out top sails hauled

Lat 1° 45' S
Long 111° 00' E

Tuesday 4th

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. and squally heading N.E. & rec'd the fore and Mizzen top sails Middle part moderate back to the Westward Latter gentle Breeze from the N.E. and fine weather heading N.W. at 9 M. Saw Ocean Island Baring N.W. & W. List 20 miles at 12 M. past with in one mile to Sward of it & hauled

Lat 00° 50' S Long 109° 52' E
