Thursday March 27th 1835

First part Light breeze from the North and fine weather heading West. Calm. Latter part Light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. to East

Friday 28th

First part Light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. Mid. & Latter Light breeze from the N.W. heading N with fine weather saw finbacks 3 or 4

Lat 33. 50

Long 134. 15

Saturday 29th

First part Light breeze from the West heading N.W. Mid. Calm. Latter Gentle breeze from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather steering N.W. with all sail out saw 2 or 3 finbacks to East

Lat 34. 40

Sunday 30th

First part Gentle breeze from S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. Mid. time haze Mid. & Latter Light breeze from N.W. heading N.W. to East Lat 34. 53

Monday 31st

First part Light breeze from the North and cloudy heading N.W. Mid. & Latter moderate gale saw 1 or 2 finbacks

Lat 35. 00

Tuesday April 1st 1835

First part Strong breeze from the North and thick evening heading N.W. took in top gallant sail and reefed the top sail at 8 o'clock took in the main sail

Latter more moderate set top gallant sails at 11 o'clock

saw the great Le Choc Island to East Lat about 35. 25. 5

Wednesday April 2nd 1835

First part Gentle breeze from the North and fine weather heading N.W. to East. To windward Mid. Light breeze heading N.W. Latter part Light breeze from the N. steering N with all sail out to East

Thursday 3rd

First part Light breeze from the N. and fine weather steering N.E. to East. Mid. & Latter Gentle breeze from East and fine weather saw and chased a finback with out success to East Lat 36. 28

Long 136. 44

Friday 4th

First part Gentle breeze from the East and fine weather steering N.E. with all sail out Mid. & Latter part Strong breeze from S.E. and once cloudy at 9 o'clock. After the breeze cleared away 2 months from the Islands to East

Saturday 5th

First part Strong breeze from S.E. and strong steering N.E. at 4 P.M. double reefed the top sail and took in the jib and main sail

Mid. Calm and thick rain Latter fresh breeze from N. and fine weather at 8 o'clock saw the Land on the West side of the Straits of Corea at 10 o'clock ship to the Eastward to East

First part moderate breeze from the North and fine weather heading E.N.E. made all sail Mid. part Light breeze from the E.N.E. heading East Latter Light breeze from the S.W. steering E.S.E. for the Straits the Land in sight to East
