Wednesday April 30th 1855

First part Gentle Breeze and thick foggy
Mid & Latter Strong gale and rugged sea
a ship lying by a whaler (S In) Lat 38.00

Thursday May 1st

First part fresh gale and rugged ship lying to
Mid much do with sharp lightning Latter moderate
and thick fog (S In)

Friday 2nd

First part Light air from the S.W. and thick
Mid & Latter part Light air from the N.W. and
quite clear at 8 A.M. saw and chased 3 whales
S In

Saturday 3rd

First part Light air from the north and some
thick at 3 P.M. spoke a Brewhol ship nothing this
season Mid & Latter Light air and quite clear
at 8 A.M. spoke the ship Doubt Boston of New Haven
20 m out 3000 nothing this season (S In)

Sunday 4th

First part Light air and quite clear saw and
chased one whale at 6 A.M. spoke Mochtasuma of
New Bedford 20 m out 22000 1 whale this season
Mid & Latter Light air and fine weather two ships in
sight (S In)

Monday 5th

First part Light air and fine weather saw and
chased one whale Mid & Latter part Light air and
fine weather saw and chased one whale going quick (S In)

Lat 38.22 Long 134.35

Tuesday May 6th 1855

First part Light air from the eastward and
misty spoke the Long Boston three ships in sight
Mid & Latter Light air from the westward and
fine weather saw and chased a whale going quick
to the S.E. (S In) No C.B.

Wednesday 7th

First part Light air and some thick
chasing to the S.E. Mid & Latter calm and
foggy. Several for a whale came on thick had
to go on board again (S In) No C.B.

Thursday 8th

First part Light air from the south and some
misty during W.S.W. Mid & Latter gentle breeze and
some haze saw and chased a whale saw a number
of Finbacks (S In)

Friday 9th

First part Light air and some foggy at 2
P.M. went to the South Mid & Latter part gentle
breeze from the eastward. Starting to the S.W. at 9 A.M.
Saw for a whale started without success at
11 A.M. started at another did not get part (S In)

Saturday 10th

First part Light Breeze and some thick. Starting
to the South Mid & Latter part Light Breeze and
fine weather at 11 A.M. spoke the ship Key (Newland)
of New Bedford 20 m out 11000 nothing this season
5 ships in sight (S In)
