

Remark On Board Ship Vermulgee

Wednesday May 21st 1855

First part Strong Breeze from the South and rugged at 3 P.M. the Boats got here one farther and the other drift and lost the whale mid is latter Strong Breeze and misty saw and chased several whales darted twice did not get fast. So end

Long 138 12.8

Thursday 22nd

First part Light ^{and} and sun thick at 2 P.M. the Boats came on board mid part calm latter part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and clear running to the westward and end

Lat 41.45

Long 137.45

Friday 23rd

First part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and fine weather ship under stowth rope having E.B. saw a Bark Bailing mid is latter part Strong Breeze and sun thick at 8 A.M. lowered anchor and killed a whale at 11.30 A.M. took him to the ship, three ship in site so end

Lat 41.58

Saturday 24th

First part Strong Breeze and rugged and rising booted on at 7 A.M. got through blowing and rising herd cut to leeward mid fresh Breeze and rising latter calm and thick fog at 12 A.M. lighted up some saw two ship. Started the works so end

Sunday 25th

First part Light Breeze from the South and thick employed in Bailing mid is latter Strong Breeze and sun thick at 6 A.M. lowered and chased three whales saw a ship cutting so end

Monday May 25th 1855

First part Strong Breeze from the N.W. and clear saw the Land at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark N.P. Perkins of New London 3 whales this season mid part strong latter Light Breeze and fine weather saw and chased whales saw several ship chasing the Land 50 miles off

Lat 42.25

Tuesday 26th

First part Light Breeze and fine weather saw and chased whales mid calm latter Light Breeze from the Eastward and fine weather saw and chased several whales the Land in site

Wednesday 28th

First Light air and fine weather saw and chased several whales darted twice did not get fast that a theme. Lower in one did not kill him mid moderate latter Strong Breeze from N.E. and raining so end

Lat 42.27.5

Thursday 29th

First part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and fine clear weather saw several finbacks mid moderate latter part fresh Breeze and fine weather saw and chased one whole several sail in site so end

Lat 42.14

Friday 30th

First part Strong Breeze and fine clear weather chased one whole darted did not get fast mid is latter moderate and sun thick commenced blowing clear and chased several whales several sail in site & hearing
