Tuesday June 10th

First part Light fresh Breeze from the S.W. and thick Steaming N.E. at dusk Shortland sail mid W. Latter Light Breeze and thick Steaming to the North at 11 A.M. Lighted up saw the Land about 8 miles off left off Steaming East saw finbacks 10 in

Lat 41.45 S

Wednesday 11th

Long 134.20 E

Came with Light Breeze and some Casey Steaming East saw finbacks Mid. Calm and thick Latter part Strong Breeze from S.E. and some thick heading N.E. to S.W. No CB

Thursday 12th

Came with Strong Breeze from S.E. and strong at 2 P.M. tack ship to the E. of the Land in site saw a whale. Mid. Light Breeze and strong heading to the S.W. at 11 A.M. tack to the E. of the Land Lat 42.55

Long 135.12

Friday 13th

First part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and fine weather heading to the E. at 6 A.M. spoke the Ship Navigator of Edgarstown 1 whale this season Mid. W. Latter Light Breeze and some thick saw and chast. two whales 4 Ship in site S.W. No CB

Saturday 14th

First part Light Breeze and fine weather at 6 A.M. spoke the Jeanne Marie nothing since we saw her Last Mid. W. Latter part gentle Breeze and thick roiling saw and chast. a whale 7 Ships in site S.W.

Monday June 15th 1835

First part Light Breeze from the Eastward and some thick got 6 lb. Beef & 3 kegs of tobacco out of Jeanne Marie Mid. W. Latter part Light Breeze and thick S.W.

Tuesday 16th

First part Light air and some thick Mid. W. Latter Light Breeze saw one whale going quick chast him S.W. Lat 42.17

Wednesday 17th

First part Light Breeze and quite clear at 5 P.M. saw the Land Mid. W. Latter gentle Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather saw and chast. two whales two Ship in site Steaming for the Land S.W.

Lat 42.25

Thursday 18th

Long 139.20

First part fresh Breeze from the S.W. and some misty at 6 A.M. spoke the Ship of shore the Land about 10 miles off Mid. Strong Breeze and some thick Latter Light air and thick fog S.W.

Friday 19th

First part gentle Breeze from the S.W. at 3 P.M. it cleared up at 5 P.M. saw and chast. a whale at 7 A.M. spoke the Ship Bahians of New Bedford 9 whales this season Mid. W. Latter Light Breeze and some thick saw and chast. a whale S.W.

Lat 43.27 S

Saturday 20th

Long 137.39 E

First part gentle Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather saw three whales going quick to the N.E. Mid. W. Latter Light air and thick at 10 A.M. lighted up saw and chast. for a whole came in thick had to come on board again saw a whale in mist
