

Remarks On Board Ship Comulgee

Wednesday July 2^d 1855

First part Strong gale from the S.W. and thick fog. The under short sail mid much the same. Latter more moderate got some coals ready for water at 11 A.M. Lighted up saw the land about 5 miles off came in thick and calm so did

Thursday 3^d

First part Light airs from the South and thick at 5 P.M. Lighted up sent a boat one shore came in thick had to stop all night mid to latter calm and thick at 12 A.M. Lighted up and the boat came off saw a good place to water if we can get a clear day. Spoke the land about nine miles off 8 Ind.

Friday 4th

First part Light airs and thick keeping close to the land mid part thick latter clear weather with a light breeze from the westward at 9 A.M. sent in a raft of coals with for water at 11.30 came off with the raft full had a man fall off the main yard on deck hurt him quite bad at 12 got the water all in and spoke the ship Navigator of Edgartown left of steering N.E. & E. three ship in site Spoke Lt 45 13

Saturday 5th

First part Light breeze from the westward and quite clear steering N.E. & E. Cape Crillon bearing bearing N.E. running from Perouses Strait mid Light breeze steering East to the light breeze from West and some thick steering East at 12 Cape Annua bearing N.E. & E. 20 miles 3 ship in site all bound through to the N.E. School

Sunday July 6th 1855

First part Light breeze from the N.W. and fine clear weather steering East mid to latter Light breeze from the South heading E.S.E. some thick so did one ship in site saw Humphreys

Monday 7th

First part Light breeze from the S.W. and quite clear saw Island at 3 P.M. Spoke the ship Navigator mid to latter light breeze and some thick saw the land

First part Light breeze from the South and some thick morning to the N.E. saw Pinback mid to latter moderate and some thick Spoke the land in site

Wednesday 9th

First part Light breeze and some thick the land in site morning to the S.E. mid to latter part gentle breeze and thick so did

Thursday 10th

First part Light airs from the S. and some thick mid to latter Light breeze from the eastward and rainy steering to the westward so did

Friday 11th

First part Light air from the East and some thick mid calm latter Light breeze from the West and quite clear heading to the westward saw two ships so did
