

Remarks On Board Ship Comutger

Saturday July 12th 1855

First part Light Breeze from the North and fine weather saw plenty of Finbacks at 6 A.M. Spoke the Ship, Spruce green, of Fairhaven 7 whals this season Mid & Latter Strong Breeze from N.E. & and thick rainy double reef the topsails & End

Sunday 13th

First part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and thick rainy Ship on different tacks under double reef top sails Mid & Latter moderate and semi thick saw plenty of Finbacks & End Lat 45-10 Long 145-30

Monday 14th

First part Light Breeze and quite clear heading to the Eastward plenty of Finbacks in site Mid & Latter fine weather employed in repairing sails plenty of Finbacks in site Lat 45-35 Long 145-00

Tuesday 15th

First part Light Breeze from the N.W. and fine weather saw plenty of Finbacks and some humpbacks at 5 A.M. Spoke the Ship, greenish & whals this season Mid & Latter gentle Breeze and some thick saw the Land & End Lat 45-20

Wednesday 16th

First part gentle Breeze and fine weather at 2 P.M. saw and heard for a right whale track and killed him at 5 took him to the Ship and hoist on the Ship Northern Light of Fairhaven 1 whale this season and American of Edgartown 2 whals this season at 5 A.M. left casting for the light at 5 Commenced again at 10 got through thick fog at 11

of Isburg Marthas Vineyard Mass

Thursday July 17 1855

First part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and thick started the Works & Mid & Latter part Strong Breeze and thick rainy at 5 A.M. Spoke the Ship Florida of Fairhaven (whal, this season & End

Friday 18th

First part Strong Breeze and quite clear heading to the Eastward at 2 P.M. Spoke the Ship, Spruce green of Fairhaven 2 whals this season Mid & Latter Light Breeze and thick Employed in boiling the Land in site & End

Saturday 19th

First part Light air and fine weather saw a right whale going quick to the S.W. Mid thick Latter gentle Breeze from the North and fine weather at 11 A.M. finished Boiling saw Finback, & End Lat 45-25

Sunday 20th

First part Light Breeze and fine weather at 5 A.M. Spoke the Ship, Green of New Bedford 1 whale & George Washington of Warrham 1 whale Latter Light Breeze and fine weather heading in for the Land several Ship in site & End Lat 45-09

Monday 21st

First part Light Breeze and fine weather Mid and Latter fine at daylight, commenced Striving saw two right whales going quick in shore 5 Ship in site one Boiling Staten Island about 25 miles off standing in shore & End Lat 45-45
