

Remarks On Board Ship Comulge

Friday Aug 1st 1835

First part gentle breeze and thick
Mid strong breeze from the W. S. W. and raining. Little
Light breeze from the West and quite clear
Saw plenty of Finback heading to the S. S. W.

Lat 45. 34
Long 148. 30

Saturday 2nd

First part Light breeze from the West and
clear saw Finback one sail in sight. Mid
is latter Light breeze and clear at 5 A.M. spoke
the Ship Spectator of Sacharaw 3 whales this season
saw two right whales going quick to the N. W. S. S.

Lat 45. 30

Sunday 3rd

First part gentle breeze from the North and fine
weather heading to the Eastward plenty of Finbacks
in sight. Mid is latter fine weather plenty of Finbacks
2 sail in sight Ship

Monday 4th

First part Light breeze and fine weather saw
plenty of Finbacks at 5 P.M. spoke the Ship Golden
Hobbsland and a whale along side. Mid moderate
latter fresh breeze from East and quite clear the land
in sight at 5 A.M. saw 6 whales going quick to the
S. S. at 9 A.M. saw 10 whales without success. Spoke
the Marcia Boat fast to a whale 3 whales this season

Lat 45. 30 Long 148. 40

Tuesday 5th

First part strong breeze with the ship sail at 2 P.M. saw round
Island about 15 miles off. Mid is latter strong breeze
and rugged round Island in sight at 11 A.M. heard
for a whale to the S. S.

of Isbury Marthas Vineyard Mass

Wednesday Aug 6th 1835

First part strong breeze and rugged at
5 P.M. saw and heard for two whales. Struck
one and the line parted. Mid is latter moderate
2 ship in sight S. S.

Lat 47. 05

Thursday 7th

First part light air and quite clear
at 2 P.M. heard for two whales. Struck
one and parted. Last the whale chased two more
round Island in sight. Mid is latter thick
air whales to the S. S.

Friday 8th

First part Light air and thick raining
saw whales. Mid is latter calm and fine
weather saw and heard for two whales all day round
Island in sight S. S.

Lat 47. 20

Long 148. 29

Saturday 9th

First part calm and clear chasing milk
one whale and started at another. Mid is
latter calm and thick at 12 saw and heard
for a whale without success S. S.

Lat 47. 14

Sunday 10th

First part Light air and some thick at 4 P.M.
shot a Burn Sawee in a Finback hit
him spouting blood lowered the Boat struck
and killed him up and the sun to and lost
him. Mid is latter Light air and saw and
heard several whales in sight S. S.
one ship in sight chasing
