

Remarks On Board Ship Cimulgee

Friday Oct 13th 1855

First part Light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather steering East at 6 A.M. sent up the main top sail yard and sail and set it Mid C to the light air and fine weather one ship in site sent up the top gallant studding sail boom S 4 30 N
Long 162. 20 E

Saturday 4th

First part Light breeze from West and fine weather steering E.S. sent the studding sails Mid C to the part moderate and fine weather two ships in site
S 48. 54 N
Long 163. 13 E

Sunday 5th

First part Light breeze from the N.W. and fine weather steering E.S. with all sail out. Mid part breeze from the North latter strong breeze from the N. and thick rainy heading E.S. to S.W. No Ck

Monday 6th

First part Fresh breeze from the N.E. and rainy heading E.S. saw a bark Mid strong breeze and rainy. Latter calm and on bent. the fore top sail it being poor and bent another bark No Ck

Tuesday 7th

First part Strong breeze from the S.E. and and rain heading E.S. and 3 P.M. took in the fore and main top sails. Closest reef the main and reef the fore sail. Mid strong gale. Latter the wind shifted to West left off steering E.S. sent the top sails to the

First part Strong gale from West steering East under double reefs Mid C Latter more moderate ship with single reefs with a main top gallant sail to the

First part Strong breeze from West and fine weather steering East. Took out the reefs Mid moderate Latter strong breeze the N.E. and squally took in main top gallant sail and but one reef in the top sails employed in getting out. Shooks for fresh water to the

Friday 10th

First part Strong breeze from the N.E. and squally heading E.S. with single reefs with a main top gallant sail over it Mid C Latter strong gale from the N.E. and cloudy took in fore top sail and closest reef the main to the

Saturday 11th

First part Strong gale from the N.E. and rugged heading E.S. at 6 A.M. reefed the fore sail and took in the main top sail Mid C Latter strong gale and cloudy to the

First part Strong gale from the N.E. and cloudy and rugged ship with closest reef main top sail and reef fore sail heading E.S. Mid C Latter strong gale and some rainy heading E.S. to the
