Friday Oct 24th 1855

First part Strong breeze from the N.E. and fine weather
Shifting S.E. Mid Strong S.W. moderate from the
E.S. heading South by East

Saturday 25th

First part Light air from the S.E. and fine weather
heading S.W. Mid the same Latter Light Breeze
tact to the E.S. and S.W.

Lat 27° 41'

Long 135° 52'

Sunday 26th

First part Light air from the South and fine
weather heading E.S. Mid S. Latter same partly employed
in washing Ship & deck

Lat 27° 08'

Long 135° 14'

Monday 27th

First part Light Breeze from the S.W. and fine
weather heading E.S. Mid calm Latter Light from
the South at 5 A.M. tact to the N.W. & S.W.

Lat 25° 54'

Long 133° 41'

Tuesday 28th

First part Light Breeze from S.W. and fine weather
heading S.E. with all sail out Mid S. Latter much
the same tact to the S.E. & S.W.

Long 135° 14'

Wednesday 29th

First part gentle Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather
heading S.E. Mid as Latter Light Breeze and fine
weather & S.W.

Wednesday Oct 25th 1855

First part calm with a small rising in the A.M.
at 4 P.M. gentle Breeze from the S.E. Rising S. with all
sail out Mid part gentle Breeze and squally Latter
gentle Breeze from the S.E. and fine weather Shifting S. out
the top mast trussing sail and main top gallant the
sail & S.W.

Lat 24° 03' N

Long 133° 10' W

Thursday 30th

First part gentle Breeze from E.S. with a heavy
swell from the S.W. Rising S.W. with all sail out
Mid S. Latter Strong trade at 9 A.M. saw the
Island of Morotoi Baring S.E. 8. Last 50 miles held
up for the Passage at 10 A.M. saw Moorea Rising
for the passage & S.W.

Friday 31st

First part Strong trades and fine weather at
4 P.M. came to anchor in Tahiti in 11 fathoms
water & S.W.

Sunday Nov 13th 1855

First part Strong trades and fine weather at
5 P.M. took our anchor and stood out for Nooroo
Mid Strong Latter gentle trades and some squally
at 7 A.M. lying of Nahoo next onshore & S.W.

Saturday 14th

First part Light trades and fine weather Ship
lying off and on Mid S. Latter Light trades and
fine weather found my letters that I have been
looking for so long & S.W.
