

Remarks On Board Ship Comulgee

Monday Dec 8th 1855

First part Light breeze from the Eastward and some squally during the middle of the latter part at 7 A.M. saw the Island Baring Mts. run in to rugged to land one ship in sight East of us and two to S.W. of us natives and one white man living on the Islands

Tuesday 9th

First part gentle breeze from the S.E. and squally during the middle of the latter part gentle breeze at daylight saw Crater Baring Mts. 40 miles running in for the land and ship in sight

Wednesday 10th

First part Light Breeze from the S.E. and fine weather at 3 P.M. went on shore and got 2 Boat Loads wood and fruit Mid. to latter part gentle breeze and fine weather took ship Magell of New Bedford and Cassack of New Bedford Employed in getting of wood and fruit 4 ships in sight

Thursday 11th

First part gentle Breeze and some squally wind from the North at 5 P.M. got through came on Board Capt. of Stirling Sound took 10 Boat Loads wood and a large quantity of fruit Mid. to latter Light Breeze from the North and fine weather no wind

First part Light Breeze from the North and fine weather during the middle of the latter part Light Breeze from the North and fine weather no wind

Saturday 13th

First part Light Breeze from the North and fine weather during the middle of the latter part Light Breeze and rainy 4 ships in sight

Lat 26.13

Sunday 14th

First part Light Breeze from the N.W. and rainy heading South with all sail out Mid. to latter Light Breeze from the S.E. and fine weather no wind

Lat 27.10

Monday 15th

First part Light Breeze from the S.E. and fine weather heading S.W. Mid. moderate latter fresh Breeze from the S.E. and some squally took in fore and mizen top gallant sails 4 ships heading S.W. no wind

Lat 27.50

Tuesday 16th

First part fresh Breeze from the S.E. and some squally heading S.W. took in main top gallant sail Mid. to latter strong Breeze and rugged reefed the fore and mizen top sail took in the main sail no wind
