could not make out what it was at dark took

First part strong breeze from the S.E. and cloudy
heading S.P.W. at dark double reef and took in
gib and mainsail Mid and latter strong gale
from S.E. and some squally S.W. and double reef
main-top sail and stensail at 11 A.M. set the top
sails double reef. Lat

Tuesday 30th

First part strong breeze from the S.W. and cloudy
heading N.E.W. at 7 A.M. were ship to the S.E.
Mid to latter moderate and cloudy S.W. with a sail
and to Ind. Lat

First part moderate breeze from S.W. and cloudy
heading S.P.E. Mid to latter fresh breeze from the
S.W. and cloudy during S.W. Lat

First part fresh breeze from the N.W. and
cloudy during S.W. reef the top sails
Mid to latter part strong breeze from the S.W.
and squally at 12 A.M. off the ship Promachus
of Mystic 3 whales this season had a squally
from the S.W. took in sail to Ind. Lat

Friday 2nd

First part strong gale from the S.W. and clear
took in the fore sail clearest reef the main
top sail Mid to latter part fresh gale and
rugged to Ind. Lat

Lat 45 50

Long 158 55

Saturday 3rd

First part more moderate with the fore
sail Mid to latter fresh breeze and rugged
at 8 A.M. off the ship Promachus at 12 saw
three right whales thick and killed one
to Ind. Lat

Lat 45 20

Sunday 4th

First part strong breeze N.W. and rugged
at 3 P.M. took the whale to the ship and hoist
on now around cut to land lost the
head at 7 got through Mid to latter strong
breeze from N.W. and rugged. Hoisted the works
saw the Promachus cutting a whale Lat

Lat 46 55

Monday 5th

First part strong breeze N.W. and rugged employed
in berling Mid to latter moderate and fine weather
at 9 A.M. lowered and struck and killed a whale
at 12 A.M. took him to the ship saw two ships in sight
