Thursday Jan 15th 1857

First part strong gale from W.S.W. and heavy squalls heading N.W. with clearest reef main top sail Mid. S. Latter much same squalls not so heavy to ends

Friday 16th

First part strong gale from W.S.W. with a heavy sea on set the fore top mast ash and main spencer heading S.W. Mid. S. Latter strong gale saw a ship heading to the south Lat 45.14

Saturday 17th

First part strong gale and squally with a heavy sea on Mid. S. Latter part more moderate and the fore sail heading to the south Lat 45.40

Long 156.30

Sunday 18th

First part moderate gale from the S.W. and squalls of rain were ship to the West S.W. set the fore and main top sail Mid. S. Latter moderate gale heading W.S.W. to ends Lat 45.13

Long 157.54

Monday 19th

First part moderate gale from the South and fine weather heading W.S.W. Mid. S. Latter moderate and fine weather heading S.W. with off sail and employed in setting reef sheets to set Lat 46.07

Long 158.34

Tuesday 20th

First part light air from the South and fine weather turning S.W. Mid. S. Latter part gentle breeze and thick rain turning to the South employed in scraping bows and setting up masts saw one Finback wh. about 4 p.m. Long 158.13

Wednesday Jan 21st 1857

First part light breeze from the N.W. and fine weather turning to the S.W. Mid. S. Latter gentle breeze from S.W. heading S.E. at 11 A.M. spoke ship Alceas of New Bedford whose this season 23rd voyage to ends

Thursday 22nd

First part gentle breeze from S.W. and fine weather heading S.E. Mid. much the same Latter gentle breeze from W.S.W. heading East to ends

Friday 23rd

First part light breeze and fine weather heading S.E. at 5 P.M. saw and chased a whaler with out success Mid. Latter part strong breeze and some squally to the N.W. to ends rain

Lat 45.00

Saturday 24th

First part fresh breeze from S.W. and some squally heading N.W. Mid. S. Latter part gentle breeze and fine weather to ends

Lat 45.53
Long 157.25

Sunday 25th

First part gentle breeze from the West and fine at 2 P.M. took ship to the S.W. Bent a new main sail Mid. S. Latter fresh gale from S.W. and cloudy heading W.S.W. to ends
