Monday Jan 26 1857

First part fresh gale from the S.W. and some squally heading S.W. Mid much the same. Later part more moderate made sail heading S.W. to S. by E.

First part Light Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy tack to the Eastward Mid is settled moderate breeze from S.W. and fine weather. During S.W. to S. by E.

Lat about 48.20

Wednesday 28

First part Light Breeze from the S.W. and fine weather. During to the S.W. Later Strong Breeze from West and some squally. During S.E. to S. by E.

Lat 48.30

Long 158.05

Thursday 29

First part Strong Breeze from the West and Cloudy. During N. at dark took in sail and left to heading S.W. Mid is. Later part Strong Breeze and rugged. Saw two Whales going quick to the Westward. at 10th set double reef top sail. S. by E.

at 48.45

Friday 30

First part Strong Breeze and rugged wind from West heading to S.W. Mid to. Later Strong Breeze from West N.W. at 6 A.M. Left off. During Capt. sent. During sail saw a whale to S. by E.

Saturday 31

First part Strong Breeze from N.W. and fine weather. During East Mid fresh gale and some squally. Took in. During sail. Later fresh gale and rugged. During Part. S. by E.

Sunday Feb 1 1857

First part moderate gale from N.W. During East Mid to. Later fresh gale and fine weather. During from West. During S.E. to S. by E.

First part fresh gale from West and fine weather. During S.E. Mid to. Later part Strong Breeze from N.W. and fine weather. S. by E.

Tuesday 3

First part Strong Breeze from N.W. and fine weather. During S.E. Bunch added two heads of Bone. Mid Strong Breeze and some Cloudy. During S.E. to S. by E. with all sail out. S. by E.

Lat 30.40

Long 133.35

Wednesday 4

First part Strong Breeze from the S.W. and some squally. During S.E. Mid Strong Breeze took in. During sail and top gallant sail at daylight. Capt. the top sails took in. Mid and Main sail at 10 took in. Fore and main top sails. See sail and cleat reef the Main top sail wind from S.W. During a heavy gale heading S.E. to S. by E.

Thursday 5

First part heavy gale from S.W. and squally. Ship heading S.E. with cleat reef. Main top sail. Mid much the same. Shift two seas but did not do much damage. Later part more moderate wind from West. Left off. During S.E. with double reef. Fore and Main top sails and fore sail. S. by E.
