Friday Feb 2 1857

First part strong breeze from West and fine weather during E.S.W. Mid 5. Latter strong breeze and thick rainy ship with all sail out to Ind

Saturday 3

First part strong breeze from West and thick rainy during E.S.W. Mid 5. Latter part strong breeze from S.W. and cloudy ship with all sail out. Studding sails to Ind

Sunday 4

First part strong breeze from the S.W. and cloudy during E.S.W. Mid 5. Latter much the same ship with all sail out. to Ind

Lat 51.31

Long 111.22

Monday 5

First part fresh breeze from S.W. and some squally during E.S.W. with all sail out. Mid 5. Latter strong breeze and some thick rainy ship with all sail out to Ind

Lat 51.44

Long 106.00

Tuesday 6

First part strong breeze from the S.W. and some thick rainy during East Mid 5. Latter strong breeze and fine weather to Ind

Lat 52.33

Long 100.30 W

Wednesday 7

First part strong breeze from the S.W. and fine weather during East Mid strong breeze and thick rainy took in top gallant sail and double reefed the top sails. Latter strong breeze from the South. At the 4th tick in Main Sail thick rainy to Ind

Homeward Bound

Thursday Feb 13 1857

First part strong breeze from the south and cloudy. At the Main Sail sent a new jib and at 11. Mid moderate breeze from the Westward and fine weather during East. At the Studding sails. Latter strong breeze from S.W. took in Studding sails and top gallant sails to Ind

Friday 13

Long 91.25

First part strong breeze from S.W. and fine weather during S.W. combas East. At the Main top gallant sail Mid 5. Latter strong breeze and some squally to Ind

Lat 35.15

Long 85.00

Saturday 14

First part strong breeze from S.W. and some squally during East. Mid strong breeze took in Main top gallant sail. Latter strong gale from S.W. with heavy squalls kept the top sails to Ind

Lat 35.20

Sunday 15

Long 81.10

First part strong gale from S.W. and squally with hail. At the Main top gallant sail over a single reef Main top Sail during E.S.W. Mid 5. Latter strong breeze from S.W. and some cloudy ship with top mast Studding sail out. to Ind

Lat 55.43

Monday 16

Long 73.10

First part strong breeze from West during E.S.W. Mid strong breeze and thick rainy took in Studding sails and Main top gallant sail. Latter strong gale from West with heavy squalls kept the fore and main top sails and two sail bending to the sail under close sail to Ind
