

Remarks On Board Ship Cominge

Saturday Feb 28th 1832

First part gentle breeze from the E.S.E. and fine weather during E.S.E. with all sail out
Mid 15th latter gentle breeze from E and cloudy during N.W. S. S. S. at 35.30

Long 48.15

Sunday March 1st 1832

First part gentle breeze from the S.E. and some foggy during N.W. and dark shortland sail and left to latter gentle breeze from S.E. and thick fog left off during N.W. S. S. S. No Ob.

Monday 2nd

First part gentle breeze from the S.E. and thick fog during N.W. at dark left to and shortland sail
Mid 15th latter part light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather leading to the N.W. S. S. S. at 34.34

Long 37.30

Tuesday 3rd

First part light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather leading to the N.W. at dark shortland sail
Mid 15th latter light breeze and fine weather at 7 A.M. saw and landed for sperm whales got one at 9 A.M. took him to the ship got one boat stove back coast on S. S. S. at 34.34

Wednesday 4th

First part light breeze and fine weather at 6 A.M. got the head off and bodily in Lt. the head long
Mid part light breeze and fine weather took the junk off and saw sperm whale land and got one set the case go at 10 A.M. took the whale to the ship and commenced cutting at 12 got the head off S. S. S. at 34.45

Thursday 5th 1832

First part light breeze and fine weather at 2 P.M. got through cutting and started the work
Mid 15th latter fine weather wind from the North saw one sail during to the S.W. S. S. S. at 34.50

Long 31.30

Friday 6th

First part light breeze and fine weather
Mid 15th latter part calm and fine clear weather employed in Baling S. S. S. at 34.59

Saturday 7th

First part calm and some rain
Latter part strong breeze from S.E. and some cloudy saw two sail during to the S.W. S. S. S. at 35.10

Long 30.59

Sunday 8th

First part strong breeze from the S.E. and cloudy at 6 A.M. got through Baling saw three sail Mid 15th latter strong breeze from the Eastward and rugged S. S. S. at 34.34

Long 31.19

Monday 9th

First part strong breeze from the Eastward and rugged at dark took in sail Mid had a squall from the S.W. and sharp lightning and some thunder
Latter strong gab from the S.W. and rugged S. S. S. at 35.29
