Friday April 10th 1857

First part light breeze from the East and fine pleasant weather steering N.W. & N. with all sail out Mid & latter gentle breeze and fine weather

Saw one sail S.W.

Saturday 11th

First part gentle breeze from East and fine weather steering N.W. & N. with all sail out got through hawking spars Mid & latter part gentle breeze and fine weather S.W.

at 12.14

Sunday 12th

First part gentle breeze from E. & S. and fine weather steering N.W. & N. with all sail out to day Mid & latter part fresh breeze and fine weather S.W.

at 14.41

Monday 13th

First part fresh breeze from E. & S. and fine weather steering N.W. & N. Mid & latter gentle breeze and fine weather S.W.

at 17.10

Tuesday 14th

First part gentle breeze from the East and fine weather steering N.W. & N. Mid & latter part light breeze and fine weather saw one sail steering to the Westward S.W.

First part light breeze from E. & S. and fine weather steering N.W. & N. Mid & latter light breeze and fine saw a sail steering to the Westward S.W.

Thursday April 16th 1857

First part light air and fine weather from E. & S. steering N.W. & N. Mid & latter light air and fine weather one sail in sight S.W.

at 21.20

Friday 17th

First part light breeze and fine weather steering N.W. & N. employed in painting ship out side Mid & latter part light air from the E. & S. and fine weather got through hawking out side. Saw an English Humer steering to the N.W. & S.W.

at 22.10

Long 53.15

Saturday 18th

First part light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. & N. Mid & latter light breeze from the N.W. & N. and fine weather heading & employed in painting ship S.W.

at 23.28

Long 55.33

Sunday 19th

First part light breeze from the N.W. & N. and fine weather tact ship to the West. Mid & latter light air tact to the N.W. & S.W.

at 25.32

Long 58.14

Monday 20th

First part light breeze from W. and fine weather heading N.W. with all sail out Mid strong breeze took in top gallant sail latter calm and fine

at 25.10

Long 59.00

Tuesday 21st

First part calm at 5 A.M. light breeze from the N.W. & N. and fine weather heading N.W. Mid fine weather latter squally with thunder and lightning and rain about the fore top sail and lost an other S.W.
