

Barge Victoria Cruising Ground 1834

Sunday November 7th These 24 hours fine breezes from the N course 8 & 9 End of the day with all ships Lat 36° 40' N Long 61° 35' W

Monday November 8th These 24 hours fine breezes from the N course 8 & 9 at 12 came up a thunder storm called all hands & then took in all sail. too a last seal Mr. Popsail & top most stowail Mr. Spencer at 6 PM set whole leavails courses light spanker Mr. top gallant sail at 10 o'clock seal the Popsail took in gill & spanker middle part ~~more~~ squally latter part more moderate at 5 PM hauled for White Whale & they proved to be Ship Back & so End Lat 36° 08' N Long 51° 09' W

Tuesday November 9th These 24 hours fine breezes from the N course 8 & 9 at 6 PM took in all sail to a last seal Mr. Popsail & Popsail & so End this day Lat 34° 52' N Long 21° 59' W

Wednesday November 10th These 24 hours fine breezes from the N course 8 & 9 at 4 PM came on board ship took up to boat & they took in sail for the night & so End this day Lat 34° 25' N Long 00° 45' W

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Thursday November 11th These 24 hours light airs & calm all the remainder of the day at 4 took in all sail Lat 34° 27' N for the night & so End this day Long 00° 34' W

Friday November 12th These 24 hours strong breezes from the N course 8 & 9 then a squall at 4 PM saw White Whale lowered but did not get him at 6 came on board & then took in sail for the night Lat 34° 25' N Long 1° 45' E

Saturday November 13th These 24 hours fine breezes from the N course 8 & 9 with all sail out at 6 PM lowered two boats down but did not get them at 6 came aboard & took them up at 4 took suit for the night Lat 34° 33' N Long 3° 04' E

Sunday November 14th These 24 hours light airs & calm all the day & so End this day Lat 34° 55' N Long 04° 13' E

Monday November 15th These 24 hours light airs from the N course 8 & 9 at 4 PM came on board ship took up to boat & they took in sail for the night & so End this day Lat 37° 34' N Long 14° 36' E

Tuesday November 16th These 24 hours light airs & calm latter part light breeze from the N course 8 & 9 at 4 PM saw white whale lowered & got one along side Lat 39° 21' N Long 29° 50' E
