S of W Course & this day all hand
employed in boiling out the whale
at 2 PM took Ship Sparrow Whale
44 months from France and Boreals, lot 35.20
of Whale & so end this day Song 8.15

Tuesday
November
28 These 24 hours light air & Calms
from the front all points off the land
all course & this day all hand employ-
ed in Stowing down the oil & so lot 34.39
end this day Song 00.00

Wednesday
November
29 These 24 hours light air & Calms
all this day from the S of W courses
& so this day all hand employed
in Stowing down the oil at 5 PM
got through Stowing down & so lot 34.24
end this day Song 8.31

Thursday
November
30 These 24 hours light breezes from
the S of W Course & at 11 AM saw
Whales, sailed by the S. quarter boat
got one Whale. Wh 12 got him along
side of our line in S & so end this day
lot 34.40
Song 9.15

Friday
November
1 These 24 hours fine Breezes from
H of S Course & H of W all hand
employed in boiling out blubber & so
lot 34.12
Song 02.49

December
2 These 24 hours light Breezes
from the S of W Course & this day
got through at 2 PM boiling and
then cleared up S of W and the lot 33.57
Song 7.39

Sunday
December
3 These 24 hours light air & Calms
from the front all points off the land
of whale landed but did not get any
& so end this day lot 34.14
Song 7.51
Lunch 8.18

Monday
December
4 These 24 hours light air & Calms
all this day from the H of W Course
& so this day all hand employed in
Stowing down at 5 PM saw Whales
landed but did not get part of lot 34.24
end this day Song 7.43

Tuesday
December
5 These 24 hours Strong Breezes from
the S of W Course & saw whale landed but
it being riced did not get part
at 4 PM took in all sail for the
night & that was lost, need Mr.
topsail & Foremast & so end this day
lot 34.38
Song 7.53

Wednesday
December
6 These 24 hours Strong Breezes from
the S of W Course & at 4 PM were
Ship made to the S of W this day
Dish & reef topsail all this day at Sun
set took all sail too disabled Mr.
topsail & Foremast & Harriet Mr. Spence
er & so end this day lot 33.06
