Sunday Kept to ship off for St. Augustin Bay

Sunday These 24 hours strong breezes from the
January H & E course S by E at 12 pulled
to 21 up the Spanker & squared the yards
for St. Augustin Bay with a
fine breeze after 11.5 P.M. to end
this day with the same Lat 16.54 S

Monday These 24 hours strong breezes from
January H & E & heavy squalls off rain &
to 22 thunder all this day took in all sail
to Suble reef, m, topsail & topmast
staysail, latter part much the same lat 18.45 S
to end this day course S by W Long 42.25 E

Tuesday These 24 hours strong breezes from
January H & E & course S by W middle
to 23 more moderate wind all sail latter
part calm at 2 P.M. struck to
anchors & put them on the bows lat 20.49 S
to end this day Long 42.56 E

Wednesday These 24 hours fine breezes from
January H & E & course S by E with all
to 24 sail on the ship at 4 P.M. sent down
our m, topsail & sent up another &
sent it to 21 lat 21.04 S
to end this day Long 42.10 E

Thursday These 24 hours fine breezes from
January H & E & course S by E with all sail
to 25 on the ship at 4 P.M. on bent the Spanker
and bent a storm Spanker lat 21.56 S
to end this day Long 41.49 E

Friday These 24 hours fine breezes from the
January H & E & course S by E with all sail on the ship lat 22.14 S
to 26 ship & to end this day Long 42.20 E

Saturday These 24 hours fine breezes from
January H & E & course S by E with all sail on the ship lat 22.19 S
to 27 at 5 P.M. came up a squall of
thunder & lightning took in all
sail to Suble reef, m, topsail & topmast
staysail at 8 P.M. whole m, & sail m, & lat 22.19 S
galloped sail so end the day with the same Long 42.20 E
calms

Sunday These 24 hours light breeze & calms
January H & E & course S by E to end
to 28 this day with the same of m, & m, lat 22.39 S
gashed in sight all this day Long 42.39 E

Monday These 24 hours light breeze & calms
January H & E & course S by E with all sail on the ship lat 23.00 S
to 29 this day in light to end this day Long 42.48 E
at 4 P.M. got up to chains & bent them

Tuesday These 24 hours light breeze & calms
January H & E & course S by E with all sail on the ship lat 23.36 S
to 30 from H & E at 4 P.M. came up abore
from H & E m, & until sunset
were ship & stood off from the land
Boring & S & sent a mile took in 4
T, galloped sail, m, topsail & m, hulled lat 23.36 S
up to main sail & topmast to end this day Long 43.48 E
Day

Wednesday These 24 hours light breezes from H & E
January H & E & course S by E with all sail on the ship lat 24.00 S
to 31 at 8 P.M. got to anchor in 4 fathoms of water
Spoke Phil Bingen off New London Capt
Smith is master out 1800 Bbls W. oil Bound
home to end the day
