Wednesday In Port this day all hand employed in getting
February off water & showing it down at 12 PM & put
to 1 went on shore & got a bulluck & so end
this day

Friday In Port this day two boats comes ashore
February one getting wood & bullock at 6 PM
to 2 came in a Spanish Slaver after slave &
so end this day

Saturday In Port this day 5 boats comes ashore
February 3 shore getting wood the other getting
to 4 goat & grass & so end this day

Sunday In Port this day one boat comes on
February shore on liberty at 4 PM Spanish
to 4 Slaver left this port & went out
with 200 slaves on board of her

Monday In Port this day some off to come on
February liberty some on shore after bullock &
to 5 so end this day with a drunken
brawl of hope that there will be no more
of it at 4 PM put over
boarder Tomas Smith in 70ns

Tuesday In Port this day 2 boats shore after
February bullock little or nothing doing
to 6 so end this day

Wednesday In Port this day 2 boats gone to Sunday
February stand after shell at 2 PM got out half
to 7 of bread & so end this day

Thursday In Port this day 10 boats comes on
February or board a French Schooner so end this day
to 8 with all hand work

Friday Middle Port of these 24 hours fine lane
February Breeze at 4 AM took down anchor & went out 23.58 &
to 1 to sea so end this day with fine lane 43.13 &

Saturday These 24 hours light air & calm from
February the N.E. breeze & 1 PM at 10 AM
to 10 took a heavy squall from the S.W. & looked
off to S.W. took in all sail to close reef
top sail 4, Staveail Main & fore at
1 PM turned out 200 reaps out to topails
set them set fore sail mainsail spanker set 00.00 &
light so end this day with fine weather long 00.00

Sunday These 24 hours strong breeze from
February the S.E. & breeze at 1 PM so end set 25.02 &
to 11 this day with lane long 42.47 &

Monday These 24 hours strong gales from
February the S.E. & breeze at 4 PM
to 12 took in all sail to close reef main
top sail fore sail 11, fore sail 11, fore sail 11
so end this day long 43.03 &

Tuesday These 24 hours strong breeze from
February the S.E. & breeze at 2 PM
to 13 PM set whole top sail 11, 7, 9, 10
trawl jib spanker mainsail & so
end this day with fine breeze set 27.00 &
or fine weather long 43.02 &

Wednesday These 24 hours strong breeze from the
February S to S.W. middle Port light winds & calm
to 14 at 3 PM came up a breeze from the S.W.
breeze S by S took in top sail 11, top sail
to 14 7, jib 4, so rain & thick weather set 00.00 &
so end this day long 00.00 &
