Thursday 24 hours time passed from
 May 23 H. 10.00 - Calcutta, we was from 5.00
 to 11.00 till 4.00 P.M. before we got
 to an anchor of this ship sent
 if the Grapt Hopper had sent him
 flying to an anchor here & this ship
 any assisted us in running a line to her
 in then helped us hasting to an anchor
 or 8 feet our sails to end this day

Friday In Port this day cleared
 May 24 up the docks on bent our 2.00 P.M.
 to 2.15 Sail on bent our 2.00 P.M. of daily
 to end this day but by 4.00 P.M. flying
 two on anchor was 12.08.8

Saturday In Port this day carried our sick
 May 25 men on shore & left two off them
 to 2.15 the other three come off at night
 of 2.00 quite smart of 2.00 of 2.00
 sea and things to be done. These getting
 smart again to end this day

Sunday In Port this day some of the men on
 May 26 shore on Liberty to end this day

Monday In Port this day some of the men on shore
 May 27 to end this day

Tuesday 28 hours this day all hands
 May 28 on board to ship this day
 to end this day

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Wednesday In Port this day all hands
 May 29 on board at 10.00 P.M. to
 to 2.15 Grapt Hopper of London left then
 Port 24 months out 1000 P.M.
 of 2.00 P.M. bound to Mayhee
 to end this day

Thursday In Port this day all hands employed
 May 30 this day in painting ship to end
 to 2.15 this day

Friday This day all hands employed in
 May 31 ship's duty to end this day

Saturday In Port this day all hands employed
 June 1 in ship's duty to end this day 244 3 4

Sunday In Port this day all hands employed
 June 2 in ship's duty to end this day
 to 2.15 Day some employed in painting
 house in letting up bobstays went
 on shore & go a boat off noon
 to end this day

Monday In Port this day washed bars &
 June 3 got our man that run away
 to end this day

Tuesday In Port this day all hands employed
 June 4 in ship's duty got one left
 to 2.15 off water 100 P.M. & showed away
 to end this day 244 3 4
