Monday Breeze 24 hours light breezes &
Calms middle latter part squally
with rain & thunder from the
E. S. & course so took in all
but two fathoms of top soil & unsailed 23.50 &
So end this day with the same Log 48.39 &

 sail at 2 p.m. at 3 p.m. reef
 M. & sail to end the day at 2.04
 more moderate Long 50.10 E

Thursday
July 19
Blow 24 hours strong Gale from
the S.W. & came Sept 10 AM
took in all sail to Port roof
in a sail for mail. It came in
Shenzen at 4 P.M. the four tomorrow
they Port took in the sail & splice
the they were it set it up for the
present until the gale abates. So end
the day with heavy squalls of wind
& rain
