

Barge Ostaria Bound to St Marys June 1838

Wednesday These 24 hours Strong breezes from S & S E Course W & with light breeze at sail & rain sail with spunker to end this day

Thursday These 24 hours Strong breezes & equally from the S & S E Course at 21.22 S all the day to end this day Long 49.14 E

Friday These 24 hours Strong breezes & equally from the S & S E Course at 20.40 S all the day to end this day Long 49.41 E

Saturday These 24 hours fine breezes from the S & S E Course at 4 P.M. took ship course at 10 with all sail on the ship to end this day at 20.50 S with fine weather Long 49.55 E

Sunday These 24 hours fine breezes from the S & S E Course at 19.55 S all the day to end this day Long 50.09 E

Monday These 24 hours fine breezes from the S & S E Course at 19.20 S all the day to end this day Long 50.24 E

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Wednesday These 24 hours Light breezes & calm from the S & S E Course at 14 P.M. got the main sail down & bent it to end this day with all sail on the ship at 2 P.M. a shower of rain at 18.32 S Long 50.25 E

Thursday These 24 hours Light breezes & calm from the S & S E Course at 4 P.M. made the land off Madagascar bearing N.W. 10 miles at 17.38 S Long 49.45 E

Friday These 24 hours fine breezes from the S & S E Course at 17.23 S all the day to end this day Long 49.14 E

Saturday These 24 hours Light breeze off the land made several tacks off & on at 9 P.M. came to anchor at St Marys in company with two French men a war one brig & ship two French Merchant Boats at 6 P.M. one of them went out bound to take off France to end this day
