Monday 4th Port of St. Moritz at 8 AM
 180 came to anchor in this Port in Company
 With 3 French Barges of War & a Salomon
 So and this day have Capt. is very sick
 I think it will turn with him & last
 tell but I hope for the better

Wednesday, Jan Post this Day all Hands were
bright & lived in Dutch going away at 4 p.m.
to 21 conveyed to Capt on shore very safe
to end this Day

28th day on boat of 4 masts this day all hands emp
 29th day lay in discharging rice To End this day
 30th day at 4 P.M. to 4 o'clock ^{was} sent out off here
 Bound & commenced after rice

Thurs day, 23rd of November this day at 9
A.M. got through with the Rice
He wrote on shore stalling up the mate
As getting ready for Sea the Light is
better and hope he will be so in a few days
that we can go to Sea if it is Gods will so
to be so End this day.

Friday, 21st Sept. Spent this day no material business
Went to Jay at 4 P.M. got up same
Lark on post. Some baskets to them
for water &c. End this day

Barque Octavia, Lying At St Marys 1838

Saturday In Post Albany this day all hands
August employe in getting water on Herring
25, 1/2 down to the Thursday

Sunday
 August 26th on Port St Marys this day at 2 PM
 the ship is all ready for sea
 at 10 AM we have shot an otter
 we have anchored on bent chain
 Stowed things below at 4 PM St
 Marys is one hour by compass
 N 10 miles with a fine breeze.
 went to S course S E E with
 all sail on the ship to end this
 day with some clouds on S side
 changing over to sun
