Saturday These 24 hours light breezes with
 December Calm from 11 AM to 1 PM
 to 1 Spoke to Logode of Rochester left 1 PM
 months out 10 Males to end this day Lat 36° 24' S
 Long 63° 42' E

Sunday These 24 hours fine breezes from
 December to 2 AM Calm from 2 AM to 11 AM with all
 to 2 sail on the ship saw with whale
 larvae get none at Sunset took in
 sail for the night to end this day Lat 35° 50' S
 Long 63° 25' E

 all this with a heavy sea on 20 and
 this day this day at 9 AM squared
 our yards for home & got 10 Males watches
 Lat 38° 20' S
 Long 65° 02' E
