Monday  
july # 4  
Port of St Helena strong breezes  
& Squally off the land at 10 Am had  
Curry on the Ship & pronounced her  
good with exceptions of her mast & them  
are ageing to be fished of then proceed  
on her passage home to End this day

Tuesday  
july # 5  
Port of St Helena fine breezes off the land  
with some showers of rain this day & wish  
left this Port English & such wexed to leave  
in a few days for Boston to End this day

Wednesday  
july # 6  
Port St Helena at 3 Pm on moved Ship  
at 12 got our anchor & maid Sail & went  
to sea with light winds from the S E  
course S W by S & fine weather saw  
an american Ship going St Helena as we  
learn out of so End this day left Log harbour  
whaler there there came aboard's home from  
each of the Ship & helped us get our anchor  
& so End this day

Thursday  
july # 7  
First Port of these 24 hours light trades  
from the S E at 5 Pm St Helena bore  
S E by S Dist 15 miles from which take  
my departer at 4 Pm Stowed the anchor  
on entent the chains & maid all Sails on  
the Ship at 6 Am brook out main  
hatches & Stowed the chains there &  
to End this day

july # 8  
These 24 hours fine trades from the S E  
course S W by S & pleasant weather painted  
jiboons let the gins to End this day

july # 13  
These 24 hours fine trades from the S E  
course S W by S to End this day

Thursday  
july # 14  
These 24 hours fresh trades from the S E  
course S W by S with fine weather  
& so ends this day

Friday  
july # 15  
These 24 hours fine trades from the S E  
course S W by S latter part heavy at  
6 Am saw a Ship steering to Southward  
to End this day

Saturday  
july # 16  
These 24 hours light trades from the S E  
course S W by S with fine weather  
one man by the name of Black appeared  
to be deserting deranged  
to End this day
