

Wed Dec the 14 1881

at 3 am commenced to moderate but still squally but not so much wind in them at 6 PM quit moderate. Antonio Jorge & Alexander Leagar sick & off duty at 9 PM commenced to breeze from the E at midnight blowing a gale

Thurs Dec the 15

com with a gale from the E & plenty of rain with the BX under a close Reef in the fore sail. Kone is on the Red Peak heading E. The Leak remains a head the same Antonio Jorge & Alexander Leagar still sick & off duty

Fri Dec the 16

com with better weather but the wind still E at 10 am wind E BX heading E. E under short sail the weather land look settled yet at 3 PM made a little more sail. In day I have been getting good fresh water. Antonio Jorge & Alexander Leagar still sick & off duty

Sat Dec the 17

com with a moderate gale of wind from the E BX under short sail heading to the E. E. at 5.30 PM had a sea to knock the Gangway Rail off on deck

Sun Dec the 18

com with bad weather wind I at times heavy squalls of rain & wind can not carry much sail with out having the decks full of water. as the Red docks is gone at 5 PM wind halled to the Westward & layed her about & lower then halled back to the E again. Antonio Jorge & Alexander Leagar still off duty

Mon Dec the 19 1881

com with squally weather and rain have had the wind changeable to day had it from the N. E. BX under short sail course E. E. at 2 PM clear weather with the wind E. W. The BX Leak is the same 8.50 strokes in 24 hours Antonio Jorge & Alexander Leagar still off duty sick

Tues Dec the 20

com with squally weather with plenty of rain in the squalls BX under short sail course E. E. at 3 PM wind halled to the W cleared up. have see 2 sail to day one Hamee & one BX merchantman

Wed Dec the 21

com with squally weather with a fresh breeze from the N. E. W. BX under short sail course E. E. E. have sun one Pinback to day. The leak remains the same a head 8.50 strokes in 24 hours

Thurs Dec the 22

com with squally weather with a fresh breeze from the N. E. W. BX under short sail course E. E. at 10 am wind halled to the N. E. still blowing a fresh breeze & squally at 4.30 PM Duffled Reeled the main top sail & lashed Reeled the fore top sail Alexander Leagar came on duty to day. Antonio Jorge still off duty

Fri Dec the 23

com with squally weather blowing a fresh breeze from the N. E. W. BX under a close Reef top sails course E. E. by E. at sunset Duffled the fore top sail at 7.30 AM Put aman in irons & made him fast to one of the main topmast back stay. He kicked again lying in his bunk. By the Name of Frederick Smith. The man that we put in irons his Name is Francis Mitchell kept in irons until 11 AM
