Mon Jan 2 com with squally weather with a fresh breeze from the S.E. B.R. under 2 Double Reef Topsails course S.E. by E at 7.30 am Mr. Joseph. Reported from the masthead a school of small sperm whales off the Lubcom 2 miles distant & coming to the windward quick toward 3 Boats for them. The Larboard Boat went a long side of one the Boat Steerer. Parted both crews at the whale. Called back his first iron again and darted at the second line and did not get fast. He made what I call a leap paw. His excuse is that the whale was under water when he darted his first iron. He sees that the whale was near enough. Why did he not hit him with his second iron. I see it go over his back one foot. A rather poor beginning I think

Wed Jan 4 com with squally weather with a fresh breeze from the S.E. B.R. under 2 Double Reef Topsails heading S.E. by E have been expecting here last 2 days. To raise the Island of St. Vincent. At day the Chronometer at 2.0 clock put its sight on top of the Island. Red of sun set up fast in sight Antonio Jorge still sick an off duty The B.R. Ohio Leak Remains the same. At Sun set more ship. heading S.E. under short sail. To day I have had the men employed in making Smit to serve the main stay with
