breeze from the N.E. at day light about 6
miles from the anchorage. At 8.30 AM
Let go the anchor at the Island of Mayo one
of the Cape Verde Island. Have been employed
in putting up the Royal Rigging and Rigging
the new Masts. Putting a Runt for the Harbord
boat and serving the main stay. Antonio Gorge
still sick and off duty

Tues Jan 17 at the Island of Mayo. This
day com. with fine weather and light breeze
from the N.E. Have had a Carpenter on board
to day a Remains the Boat Boole works. Have
been employed in the Rigging. Antonio Gorge
still sick and off duty

Wed Jan 18 at the Island of Mayo
This day com. with fine weather with
a light breeze from the N.E. Have had the
Carpenter from shore a day to day to work
Have been setting up the Head Rigging to day
Antonio Gorge still sick and off duty

Thurs Jan 19 at the Island of Mayo. This
Day com. with fine weather with a light breeze
from the N.E. To day I have fixed the coal bin
boarded down some of the Rigging. Put a Runt
to the Harbord Boat. Had have done some odd
jobs in the Rigging. Antonio Gorge still sick and
off duty. To day the Captain sent off a Fore
quater off Reef

Fri Jan 20, com. with fine
weather at the Island of Mayo. Last night
I put one man in Irons. He had some rum from
shore unknown to any of us and had drunk
made some noise and his Rifle and Chisel
to use it so I just slipped a pair of Irons
on him. His name is John W Brown

Sat Jan 21 1882 At the Island of
Mayo. This day com. with fine weather
N.E. Employed in odd jobs in the Rigging
John W Brown still in Irons

Sun Jan 22 At the Island
of Mayo. This day com. with fine weather
wind at N.E.

Mon Jan 23 com. with pleasant
weather with a fresh breeze from the N.E.
At the Island of Mayo. John W Brown still
in Irons. Antonio Gorge still sick and off duty

Tues Jan 24 com. with pleasant
at the Island of Mayo. John W Brown
still in Irons down in the after hold. Have
been employed in the Rigging

Wed Jan 25 At the Island
of Mayo. John W Brown still in
Irons. At 8 PM. I took the Irons off of
John W Brown on his promise of good
behavior

Thurs Jan 26 At the Island of
Mayo. This day com. with fine weather with
a light breeze from the N.E. Have been
employed in the Rigging. Antonio Gorge still
sick and off duty

Fri Jan 27 At the Island of Mayo
This day com. with fine weather

Sat Jan 28 At the Island of
Mayo. This day com. with pleasant weather
with a fresh breeze from the N.E. To day
I have painted the 2 quater boats
Antonio Gorge still sick and off duty
