March 1st 1882 Com with Hazy weather
blowing a fresh breeze from the S.E. & R.R.
under 2 Double Reef Topsails & cruising at
5 PM Raised a school of small sperm whales
toward the ship. One L.B. struck first and
killed the imm. whale came up close to the
B.B. and Mr. Jasper struck again then
the L.B. and the Vauld B. struck 2 others
The L.B. whale ran to the windward
so Rugged could not hold on. Rugged to
him until after dark 8 miles to the wind
ward of the ship and all along. Rugged the
whale spouting good blood then he started
to run north then East. Rugged the boat
under full of water but we made
out to get the water out of her before we
flooded over & cut the line just in time
so we saved 2 whales L.B. and V.B.

Thurs March 2nd Com with a moderate
gale can not cut the whales to day at 2 PM
one of them killed the black chain. Toward
the L.B. and R.B. and then made sail on
the ship and got him a long side again.

Fri March 3rd Com with a fresh
breeze and Rugged at 4 AM commenced to
cut. Finished cutting at 4 PM then started
the works.

Sat March 4th Com with a fresh
breeze from the S.E. Employed in boiling
Broke out Fresh water.

Sun March 5th Com with a fresh
breeze from the S.E. & R.R. under 2 Double
Reef Topsails. Finished boiling at 4 PM.

Mon March 6th Com with fine weather
with a nice breeze from the S.E. & R.R. under
short sail. Employed in blowing down
oil. At 1 PM Raised a school of sperm whales
The L.B. struck a whale at 1.30 PM and
killed him Brought him to the ship at 4 PM.

Tuesday March 7th 1882
Com with fine weather with a light breeze
at 4 AM Com mended to cut. Finished
cutting at 9 AM started the works at 10 AM.

Wed March 8th Com with fine weather
with a nice breeze from the S.E. Finished
boiling at 4 AM. Have seen one Seagull to
day. and one bird called it a whale.

Thursday March 9th Com with a fresh
breeze from the S.E. & Hazy weather at 3.30
PM Raised a school of small sperm
whales. Toward the 4 boats. L.B. struck
then the B. Boat, then the C. Boat. B. Boat
Iron dramed, got the whale. L.B. &
B. Boat took her whale to the ship
a bout dark.

Fri March 10th Com with fine
weather with a nice breeze at 9 AM.
Com mended to cut. Finished cutting
at 3.30 PM. Started the marks at 3.30
PM.

Sat March 11th Com with clear weather
with a fresh breeze from the S.E. & R.R.
Heading to the N.E. under short sail
Finished boiling at 11 AM.

Sun March 12th Com with Hazy weather
with a fresh breeze from the S.E. & R.R. under
short sail & cruising at dark. Killed a sperm
whale going to the windward. mat so late
did not lower.

Mon March 13th Com with fine weather
with a nice breeze from the S.E. & R.R. under
short sail & cruising. Have been blowing down
oil to day off St Antonio.
