Wed March 15 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under whole topsail heading to the E. S. E. at 5 P.M. sighted a school of 12 ball sperm whales to the windward. Toward for them. The whales went to the windward did not see them from the boat. As they once from the ship after the boat was down then went out of sight

Thurs March 16 com with clear weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under whole topsail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony

Fri March 17 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under easy sail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony. Today we put a man in irons by the name of John Brown for drawing a knife on a man by the name of Patrick Morrissey. We called 2 other men up that saw the row and they told the same story. That Patrick Morrissey did so we put John Brown in irons and put him down in the after hold

Sat March 18 com with heavy weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under short sail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony. John Brown still in irons. Every day & to day we have caught 4 lbs of fish and sold them. Have seen 4 sail to day merchant men

Sun March 19 com with heavy weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under short sail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony. John Brown still in irons and down in the after hold

Mon March 20 com with fine heavy weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under short sail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony at 8 A.M. let John Brown out of irons on his promise of good behavior

Tues March 21 com with heavy weather blowing fresh from the E. S. E. B. R. under easy sail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony. Have seen one school of killers today. The cook is sick & off duty. He has got a bilious attack. He feels better to night

Wed March 22 com with heavy weather blowing a moderate gale from the E. S. E. B. R. under short sail a cruising off of the Island of Saint Anthony. The cook is still sick an off duty

Thurs March 23 com with heavy weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. B. R. under short sail a cruising. The Island of Saint Anthony in sight

Fri March 24 close in to the Island of St. Anthony at 1 P.M. The captain took a boat and boat crew & went a shore to a bay call Carragal bay. Had one man to runaway by the name of John Brown. Seized a man or brought them off to go in the ship

Sat March 25 com with a fresh breeze off of the Island of St. Anthony. Have been employed to day in setting up the main Rigging and Broke out fresh water
