

Fri June th 30 1882 com with fog
squalls with a fine breeze from the N
B.R. under all sail heading N.W. at 4 P.M.
steered W & N

Sat July th 1 1882 com with squally weather
with a fresh breeze from the N.E. Course W & N
at 3 P.M. Halted on the wind heading N.W. & N
The day had a man go out his little boat off a splashing
wood for the cork broke out fresh water & day
have seen nothing since leaving Fagat that
look like a sperm whale

Sun July th 2 com with fine weather with
a nice breeze from the N at 5 P.M. gained with
the Schooner E.B. Connell

Mon July th 3 com with fine weather with a
nice breeze from the N.E. B.R. under all sail
at 4 P.M. gained with the E.B. Connell

Tues July th 4 com with squally weather
with a nice breeze from the N.W. course
at 1 P.M. wind N.W. B.R. heading N.W.
The man that cut his foot last Saturday
is still off duty his name is Joseph Lehu
The Schooner E.B. Connell still in sight

Wed July th 5 com with foggy weather with
a nice breeze from the N.W. B.R. clearing
different courses during the day a cruising
at sun set put her under short sail &
now ship the E.B. Connell still in sight
Joseph Lehu still off duty

Thurs July th 6 com with hazy weather with a
nice breeze from the N B.R. under a main top
gallant sail a cruising

Fri July th 7 1882

com with squally weather blowing a
moderate gale from the N.W. B.R. under
short sail heading to the S at meriden
better weather at 4 P.M. exchanged Longitudes
with a French Barque at 4.30 P.M. the
Schooner E.B. Connell spoke us Capt
Costa came on board stopped about a
quarter of hour. at sun set rain.
Joseph Lehu still off duty

Sat July th 8 com with squally weather blowing
a strong breeze from the N.W. B.R. under
2 full top sails clearing different
courses during the day from E.B. Connell
The Schooner E.B. Connell still in sight
Joseph Lehu still off duty

Sun July th 9 com with clear weather with
a fresh breeze from the N.W. B.R. under a
main top gallant sail a cruising at 2 P.M.
Raised a school of sperm whales going to the
windward quick. Toward for them did not
see them from the boat came on board in
about one hour more. Raised another pod of
whales coming quick to the windward
Toward for them. but right over took
us before we got to them

Mon July th 10 com with fine weather with a
nice breeze from the N.W. B.R. under all sail a
cruising. To day put 2 men in guns for fighting
their names are as follows one Frederick Smith
& Manuel Domingo. Took sperm whale triped
them up in the rigging kept them there a
bout 2 hours then took them down put one
of them down in the after hole the other down
in the fore hole. Joseph Lehu still off duty
