

Tues July th 11 1882 com with fine
mether with a nice breeze from the S
B.R. under all sail a cruising at 4 AM took
Fredrick Smith & Manuel Penningo out of
front. To day I have taken 2 cask of coal & I
put in the coal bin also one barrel

Wed July th 12 com with fine mether with
a nice breeze from the S.B.R. under all sail
a cruising at 3 P.M. Had a gam. with the
Schooner E.B. Connell Capt Costa

Thurs July th 13 com with pleasant
mether with a light breeze from the W. & N.
B.R. under all sail a cruising. The Schooner
E.B. Connell still in sight Joseph Gelhu
still of duty on account of his foot

Fri July th 14 com with a fresh breeze
from the W. & N. B.R. heading S.W. at 3 P.M.
wind backed to the W. & N. B.R. heading N
at sunset a fine breeze E.B. Connell still in
sight. Joseph Gelhu

Sat July th 15 com with clear mether with
a fresh breeze from the S.W. B.R. under 2 Bble
Rysl Topsail. E.B. Connell in sight to the
Leeward at 2 P.M. the E.B. Connell. Raised
whales we kept off for her and made fall
when we got to the schooner. They had 2
small whales dead & the rest of them
had left we spoke the schooner, Capt
Costa told us the course that the whales
were going at 4 P.M. we raised them toward
for them at 5.30 P.M. the waist board threw
a large whale then all of the boat got
fast to him got him to the ship at 8 P.M.

Sun July th 16 1882
com with clear mether with not much wind.
but a heavy swell which makes bad cutting
at 4 am commenced to cut. Finished cutting
at 6 P.M. at 8 P.M. commenced to boil

Mon July th 17 com with fine mether
with a light breeze. Employed in boiling.
The E.B. Connell close to a boiling also at 1
P.M. calm. Capt Costa came on board

Tues July th 18 com with fine mether
Employed in boiling. E.B. Connell still in
sight. Joseph Gelhu still off duty

Wed July th 19 com with fine mether with
a light breeze from the S.B.R. under short
sail a boiling at 11 AM the Captain went
on board of a Topsail Schooner to put
letters on board of her at 2 P.M. equally
& finished boiling at 8 P.M.

Thurs July th 20 com with clear mether
with a fresh breeze from the S. & B.R.
under short sail all hands Employed
in stowing down oil. Finished at 6 P.M.

Fri July th 21 com with fine mether with
a nice breeze from the S.W. B.R. under all sail
a cruising at 1 P.M. Raised the E.B. Connell
a cutting 2 small whales. To day I have Repaired
the Bulging gib

Sat July th 22 com with pleasant mether
with a nice breeze from the S.W. B.R. under
all sail a cruising

Sun July th 23 com with fine mether with
a nice breeze from the S.W. B.R. under
all sail heading W. at sunset Packed ship
& put her under short sail
