

Mon July th 24 1882
This day com with fine weather with
a nice breeze from the N.E. at 3 P.M.
Sailed with the E.R. Connell at 7 P.M.
Raised a school of sperm whales. Made
with the E.R. Connell. Capt Renton
struck a whale & the mate of the E.R.
Connell. Both lost the whales. Then I
struck & the second mate of the schooner
a boat 2 o'clock at night. We saved both
of our whales & took them a long side
of the Ohio

Tues July th 25 com with hazy weather
with a fine breeze from the N.E. at 5.30
AM commenced to cut the whales. Finished
cutting at 9.30 AM started to boil at 4.30
P.M.

Wed July th 26 com with a fresh breeze
from the N.E. & R.X under short sail heading
N.E. Employed in boiling. Joseph Lehu still
off duty

Thurs July th 27 com with clear weather
& blowing a fresh breeze from the N.E.
R.X under short sail a cruising
The E.R. Connell in sight. Finished
Boiling at 5 AM

Fri July th 28 com with clear weather
with a fresh breeze from the N.E. R.X under
short sail heading N.E. at 2 P.M. Sailed
with the E.R. Connell

Sat July th 29 com with bad weather
blowing a moderate gale from the N.E.
R.X under short sail heading N.E.
this afternoon slowed down all the E.R.
Connell. Still in sight

Sun July th 30 1882
Com with a moderate gale from the N.E. & R.X
under short sail heading N.E. E.R. Connell
in sight Joseph Lehu still off duty

Mon July th 31 com with a fresh breeze
from the N.E. & R.X under short sail
a cruising at Meriden quite dead-end weather
at 2 P.M. Sailed with the E.R. Connell

Tues Aug th 1 1882 com with hazy weather
with a light breeze from the N.E. To day
let the E.R. Connell have her share of the
oil. To day took the Boston oil out of Barrels
and put it in a cask. Joseph Lehu still
off duty

Wed Aug th 2 com with hazy weather
with a light breeze from the N.E. & R.X under
all sail heading N.W. To day slowed down in
the Bos Hole one cask of Boston oil. The
E.R. Connell still in sight. Mrs Perry the
fourth mate is off duty on account of
a sore leg. Joseph Lehu still off duty

Thurs Aug th 3 com with hazy weather with a
light air from the N.E. & R.X under all sail
heading N.E. at 3 P.M. a fine breeze Mrs Perry &
Joseph Lehu still off duty

Fri Aug th 4 com with hazy weather with a nice
breeze from the N.E. & R.X under all sail heading
N.E. by E. The E.R. Connell still in sight

Sat Aug th 5 com with a fresh breeze from
the N.E. & with fog squalls. R.X under
topsail heading N.E. by E. at sunset wore ship
Dabled Reefed the Topsail
