

Mon Oct th <sup>16</sup> 1882  
 This day commences with fine weather with  
 a head wind to sail. The deserters still absent  
 Mr Perry still off duty  
 Tues Oct th 17 at Tenerife still wind  
 bound. Deserters still absent

Wed Oct th 18 at the Island of Tenerife  
 still cannot sail on account of the wind  
 Deserters still absent Mr Perry still off duty

Thurs Oct th 19 at Tenerife 20 day  
 it is a calm. Deserters still absent  
 Mr Perry our fourth mate sick & off duty

Fri Oct th 20 This day sailed from  
 the Island of Tenerife at 6 AM sailed  
 with out our Deserters. Steered by W & W  
 at one P.M. set a stunsail at sun set. still a  
 fine breeze from the N.E.

Sat Oct th 21 com with pleasant weather with  
 a fine breeze from the N.E. B.R. under all sail  
 course S.W. by W. at 6 P.M. steered S.W. by W.  
 The B.R. Desdemona is in sight

Sun Oct th 22 com with clear weather  
 with a strong breeze from the N.E. course  
 S.W. by W. at 9.30 AM Raised a large  
 sperm whale. Mated with the B.R.  
 Desdemona bound toward for him our  
 B. Road went a long side of him 2 times  
 but did not fasten solid. Rather time  
 then the whale went to the windward  
 called the boats a board

Mon Oct th 23 com with fine weather  
 with a stiff breeze from the N.E. B.R. under  
 all sail course S.W. by W. B.R. Desdemona  
 still in sight

Tues Oct th <sup>24</sup> 25 com with pleasant  
 weather with a nice breeze from the N.E.  
 B.R. under all dipping sail course S.W. by W.  
 until 2 P.M. Then steered S.W. & S

Wed Oct th 25 com with hazy weather  
 with a fresh breeze from the N.E. B.R. under  
 all sail course S.W. by S at sun set  
 steered W by S & S Mr Perry still off duty

Thurs Oct th 26 com with hazy weather  
 with a strong breeze from the N.E. B.R.  
 under all sail course W by S & S  
 10 day when we got a sight we  
 found that St. Nicholas was 33  
 miles off. Raising E.O.P.E. they must  
 be a strong current setting to the E.  
 so now we have got a dead beat  
 for the Island. At sun set Double Reefed  
 the Topsails. The fourth mate still sick & off duty

Fri Oct th 27 com with hazy weather with  
 a fresh breeze from the N.E. at daylight  
 Raised the land on the weather beam at 4  
 P.M. set off of the Island of St. Nicholas  
 at 3 P.M. light airs & changeable Mr Perry  
 still sick & off duty

Sat Oct th 28 com with hazy weather  
 wind of E. at 3 P.M. let go anchor at St  
 Nicholas

Sun Oct th 29 com with fine weather  
 wind of N.E. Lying at anchor at the Island  
 of St. Nicholas

Mon Oct th 30 at the Island of St. Nicholas  
 to day had 2 men to desert

Tues Oct th 31 at St. Nicholas had 3 more  
 men to run to day. Deserters still absent
