up the waist & bow boat. Ready to paint  
washed the ship out side at 11 AM Capt  
Benton went on shore. Mr Perry still  
sick & off duty

weather at 9 am Anchored at Port Praya  
Came here on a count of the Captain.  
not being in very good health the  
Doctors say that he has the dropsy

Fri Nov 10<sup>th</sup> At Port Praya  
To day. Took on board Lon. Crenger

Sat Nov 12<sup>th</sup> At Port Praya

Anchor and left the Island bound  
S. S. W
