Sat Nov th 18 com with fine weather with a light breeze from the S.E. & R under all sail heading S.W. To day have been setting up Shocks

Sun Nov th 19 com with pleasant weather with light air from the S.E. at times calm R under all sail heading from S.W. the Steward is still sick & off duty

Mon Nov th 20 com with a light air from the S.E. R under all sail S.W. Broke out Fresh water to day at 3 P Toward for Black Fish. Caught One. The Steward still off duty

Tues Nov th 21 com with light air from the S.E. with light squalls. To day looked out for Black Fish

Wed Nov th 22 com with a light breeze from the S.E. R heading S.W. by W. To day sent down the Fore Top sail Repaired it & sent it up again. The Steward still sick & off duty

Thurs Nov th 23 com with squally weather with a light breeze from the S.E. & R under all sail heading S.W. at 9 am fine weather sent down the Mizzen Topmast Stay sail & Repaired it & sent it up again. at 6 P.M. more squalls. Took in the light sails & Hurled them

Fri Nov th 24 1882
This day com with fine weather with a light breeze from the S.E. & R heading S.W. To day sent down the main Top sail & Repaired it & sent it up again. The Steward still sick & off duty

Sat Nov th 25 com with fine weather with a light breeze from the S.E. & R heading S.W. To day sent down the Fore course & Repaired it & sent it up again. The Steward still sick & off duty at dark light rain squalls

Sun Nov th 26 com with fine weather with a light breeze from the S.E. & R under all sail heading S.W. Fine sail in light Merchantmen Steward still off duty

Mon Nov th 27 com with fine weather with a light breeze from the S.E. & R under all sail heading S.W. 4 sail in light Merchantman

Tues Nov th 28 com with fine weather with a fine breeze from the S.E. & R under all sail heading S.W. To day Broke out fresh water at 5 P.M. had a Squall

Wed Nov th 29 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the S.E. & R under all sail heading S.W. by E. To day Repaired the main Stay sail & Spanker. Then bent them

Thurs Nov th 30 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the S.E. & R heading S.W. At 1 P.M. Raised the Wind of Fernando Noronha. To day Repaired the Main Course & Flying Jib. We have 2 men toward Dick with the Boats Nigger this morn. one Jose Manuel the other we call Jacko. The Steward still sick & off duty
