at 8 AM commenced to cut finished  
at noon started the masts at 6 P.M.  
the sick still off duty

Fri Dec th 15 com with fine weather  
with a light breeze employed in boiling  
Finished boiling at 9 P.M. Had to men to  
getting out a fighting. Toward. The same man  
picked up the row. Manual Perosa one  
that we have had in Grows for the same  
space before I believe that was a fighting  
a bout a match. The other one of them  
is John Manuel Perosa. The Captain  
sent them to the Mast Head about  
3 hours. Then called them down & put  
them in Grows. put one down in the  
after hole the other one down in  
the run

Sat Dec th 16 com with fine  
weather with a nice breeze from the N.E.  
employed in clearing up decks at 10 AM  
hoisted the Topsails Steered S.W. by N. at 6 P.M.  
Took John Manuel Perosa out of Grows  
at 6.30 P.M. course W. S. W.

Sun Dec th 17 1882  
This day com with bad weather. Blowing  
a strong breeze from the S. & Raining  
B.R. under short sail heading W. S. W.  
at 6 P.M. Took Manuel Perosa out of Grows

Mon Dec th 18 com with squally  
weather wind from the S. Can't steer  
down oil to day. B.R. under short sail  
heading W. S. W. at 6 P.M. Took ship  
heading to the S. E. & E

Tues Dec th 19 com with fine weather  
with a fine breeze from the S. B.R. under  
short sail heading S. E. by E. To day have  
been employed in stowing down oil. Finished  
at 4 P.M. at 7 P.M. Took ship heading W.

Wed Dec th 20 com with fine weather  
with a light breeze from the S. P. E. B.R.  
under all sail heading S. E. & N. To day  
have been employed in washing ship. The  
sick still off duty

Thurs Dec th 21 com with a calm at 4 AM  
light air from the S. E. employed in ship  
duty. The sick still off duty

Fri Dec th 22 com with fine weather with  
a light breeze from the N. B.R. under all sail  
only S. by E. Have been employed in ship duty.  
The sick still off duty. The Steward rather  
improves

Sat Dec th 23 com with squally weather  
with Ruffling winds. To day repaired the cutting  
sage. fixed the masts but with iron hoops  
at 6 P.M. course S. S. W. John Perosa the man  
that fell from a loft came on duty to day
