Wed Dec th 27 com with a light breeze from the S.W. B.R. under all sail heading S.W. 1/4 W. To day have shied many Topsail Braces. Took the old ones & made five braces out of them. Broke out Fresh water. The sick still off duty.

Thurs Dec th 28 com with clear weather with a nice breeze from the N.E. & B.R. under all sail course W. S. W. To day put up Straps to the many Topsails back blocks. The sick still off duty.

Fri Dec th 29 com with fog squalls with a nice breeze from the S.W. B.R. under all sail course W. S. W. at 4 P.M. wind S.W. & squally. Took in the light sails & Dubbed & reefed the Topsails at 4 P.M. clear weather. Wye ship heading W. S. W. To day over hauled the straps to the main brace blocks. The sick still off duty.

Sat Dec th 30 com with hazy weather with a breeze from the S.W. B.R. heading W. at 4 P.M. light rain squalls with light air. The sick still off duty.

Sun Dec th 31 1882 com with cloudy weather with a nice breeze from the S.W. B.R. under all sail heading S.W. at 3 P.M. a fresh breeze from the same quarter at 7 P.M. now ship heading W. S. W. The sick still off duty.

Mon Jan th 1 1883 com with pleasant weather & a calm. Employed in ship duty. The sick still off duty.

Tues Jan th 2 com with pleasant weather with a light breeze from the N.E. & B.R. under all sail course W. S. W. Have hid up the 2 bob stays. Toward to day. The sick still off duty.

Wed Jan th 3 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the N.E. & B.R. under all sail course W. S. W. Have been employed in the Rigging. The sick still off duty.

Thurs Jan th 4 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the N.E. & B.R. under all sail course W. S. W. To day put some iron hoops around the Rider head. The sick still off duty.

Fri Jan th 5 com with fine weather with a nice breeze from the N.E. & B.R. under all sail course W. S. W. at 3 P.M. started S.W. by S. The sick still off duty.

Sat Jan th 6 com with hazy weather with a light breeze from the N.E. & B.R. under all sail course S.W. by S. at 1 P.M. spoke a brig the Carpuage bound to Bernabuke Capt Benton sent letters by her at 3 P.M. Had a squall from the S.W. at 7 P.M. a light air from the S.E.
