course S.W. At 7 P.M. a calm. To day
Jaco Maria Crespo & Jose Manuel Santos
2 of the men that was sick. Came on duty
To day we have only one sick & off duty
now. That one is the Steward

Sun Jan th 21 Com with clear weather with
a fresh breeze from the S.W. Bx under 2
Double Reef Topsails course S.W. at 10 AM
wind halled to the S.W. Bx heading S.P.E.
At 5 P.M. wind halled back to the S.W.
& commenced to breeze on heading W by S

Mon Jan th 22 Com with cloudy weather
blowing strong from the S.W. Bx under
2 close Reef Topsails heading W.S.W. At 3
P.M. a calm. At 4 P.M. commenced to breeze on

Tue Jan th 23 com with bad weather blowing
a gale from the S.W. Bx under 2 close Reef
Topsails untill 6 AM. Then furled the Fore
Topsail. At 3 P.M. commenced to moderate
But still the weather looks bad

Wed Jan th 24 com with a gale from the S.W.
Bx. Now is under close Reef main Topsail
Jaco Maria Crespo & Jose Manuel Santos
is sick & off duty again

Thurs Jan th 25 The gale still continues blowing
heavily in squall. The sick still off duty

Fri Jan th 26 com with a fresh breeze &
squally at 10 AM fine weather at 6 P.M. a calm

Sat Jan th 27 com with clear weather with a
new breeze from the S.W. Bx under all sail
course S.W. at 2 P.M. a strong breeze then started
S.P.E.

Sun Jan th 28 1883
com with fine weather with a fine breeze
from the S.W. Bx under all sail course S.W. by S
The sick still off duty

Mon Jan th 29 com with a gale from
the S.W. Bx under 2 close Reef Topsails
heading S.P.E.

Tue Jan th 30 com with squally weather with
a breeze from the S.W. Bx under 2 Double
Reef Topsails heading S.P.E. at 2 P.M. fine weather
at 6 P.M. made all sail wind S.W. course S.W.
Have seen nothing that looks like a whale yet

Wed Jan th 31 com with squally weather
with a fresh breeze from the S.W. Bx under
Topsails heading S.P.E.

Thurs Feb th 1 1883 com with fine weather
with a fresh breeze from the S.P.E. Bx
under 2 Double Reef Topsails heading S.W. by W
at 2 P.M. wind S.W. heading W.S.W.

Fri Feb th 2 com with heavy weather blowing
strong strong from the S.W. Bx under 2
close Reef Topsails heading S.P.E. at 9 AM
started to the Northward at 4 P.M. fine
weather

Sat Feb th 3 com with fine weather with a light
breeze from the S.W. Bx under all sail course
W.S.W. at 1 P.M. a boat calm Capt Renton
went on board of an English Barque to compare
the Chronometers we found that we was 50
miles apart

Sun Feb th 4 com with pleasant weather
with a fine breeze from the S.W. Bx under all
sail course W. At 2 P.M. a fresh breeze at 3 P.M.
Raised the Land. The South side of St George
Gulf or Cape 3 points at 4 P.M. from ship.
heading S by E
