com with fine weather with a light breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E. The Steward still sick & off duty

Wed April th 4 com with pleasant weather with a light air from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E.

Thurs April th 5 com with pleasant weather with a light breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E. by N at 3 P.M. commenced to get squally

Fri April th 6 com with squally weather with light air from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E. by N at 4 AM raised the line going N. the Steward still off duty

Sat April th 7 com with fine weather with a light breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. by W at 2 P.M. rain squalls & calm at dark a light breeze

Sun April th 8 com with clear weather & calm

Mon th 9 com with pleasant weather with a light air from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E. by N. The Steward still sick & off duty

Tues April th 10 com with a light breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E.

Wed April th 11 com with fine weather with a light breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. by E. The Steward still sick & off duty

Thurs April th 12 com with squally weather with a breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. E. by N

Fri April th 13 com with fine weather with a nice whole sail breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. by W. The day page has been employed in putting new bolts in the windlass & cleaning it

Sat April th 14 com with pleasant weather with a fine breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. by W. The Steward still sick & off duty

Sun April th 15 com with clear weather with a fine breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail heading N. at 3 P.M. light squalls

Mon April th 16 com with clear weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. at 4 AM. Raised a school of small sperm whales. Toward fore mizzen. The L. Boat struck first & got stove filled with water & rolled over & another whale hit the line off the B. Boat & went head struck & lapped their whales. Took them to the ship at 10 30 AM. Commenced to cut them at 1 P.M. Finished at 4.30 P.M.

Tues April th 17 com with squally weather with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under 2 B. Reef Topsails course & by N at daylight this morning commenced to boil

Wed April th 18 com with a fresh breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under short sail course N. W. by N. Finished boiling at 3 P.M.
