under all sail cruising at 4 30 P.M. Landed  
with the Bx Dropick Reed Capt Stanton

Mon April th 23 com with a strong  
breeze from the E. S. E. heading N. N. E.

Tues April th 24 com with a fresh  
breeze & squally Bx heading N. N. E.

Wed April th 25 com with a fresh  
breeze from the E. S. E. heading N. N. E.  
I suppose that we are bound to day  
The Steward & Cook still sick & off duty

Thurs April th 26 com with a fresh breeze  
from the E. S. E. squally Bx heading N. N. E.

Fri April th 27 1883  
This day com with squally weather  
with a fine breeze from the E. S. E.  
under all sail heading N. N. E. To day  
Repaired the Scuttle Butt & broke out  
fresh water

Sat April th 28 com with fine  
weather with a light breeze from the  
E. S. E. under all sail heading N. N. E.  
To day have been employed in basting  
out & provisioning. The Cook & Steward  
still sick & off duty

Sun April th 29 com with fine weather  
with a nice breeze from the E. S. E.  
under all sail heading N. N. E. The Cook  
& Steward still sick & off duty

Mon April th 30 com with pleasant weather  
with a light breeze from the E. S. E. under  
all sail heading N. N. E.

May th 1 1883 com with pleasant  
weather with a light breeze from the E.  
Bx under all sail heading N. N. E. The cook is  
well & on duty

May th 2 com with pleasant weather & calm  
To day have been employed in scraping down  
the mast made a Spid sent in the Flying  
jib & Repaired it & bent it a gam

May th 3 com with pleasant weather with a  
light breeze from the E. S. E. Bx under all sail course  
N. N. E. at 1 P.M. light Rain squalls with light  
baffling winds. To day have been employed in cleaning  
iron work. made the main Toppallent staysail  
smaller

Fri May th 4 com with squally weather with  
E. S. E. at sun set better weather Bx under all  
sail heading N. N. E. The Steward still sick  
& off duty
