

Wednesday July 4th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Northward and fair weather headed to the Westward still cruising the two Schs insight so ends.

Thursday 5th First and Middle part this day fine breeze from N^W and passing clouds Latter part strong breeze and foggy squalls steered S by W at 9 1/2 a m saw whales going quick to the windward lowered the boats at noon boats came on board unsuccessful whales went out of sight to the windward so ends.

Friday 6th Commence with strong breeze from N^W and foggy squalls set the sails and look fore the whales but saw nothing of them Middle and Latter part strong breeze and cloudy weather still cruising so ends.

Saturday 7th All this twenty four hours strong breeze from N^W and cloudy weather still cruising saw nothing so ends.

Sunday 8th First and middle part this twenty four hours strong breeze and cloudy weather Latter part fresh breeze from Westward and rain squalls still cruising so ends.

Monday 9th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and calm Employed in repairing the main sail saw blackfish lowered the boats but got none so ends.

Tuesday 10th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and fair weather Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends.

Wednesday 11th All this twenty four hours light Westerly wind and fair weather hands Employed in ship duty still cruising so ends.

Thursday 12th All this twenty four hours light breeze from W^NW and passing clouds still cruising so ends.

Friday 13th First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from N^W and fair weather headed S^W by W At midnight had squall from Eastward and some rain headed N by E Latter part headed N^NW so ends.

Saturday 14th This day commence with fine breeze from N^E and fair weather headed N^W by N At 2 p m keep her off and steered W by N Middle and Latter part the same so ends.

Sunday 15th This day commence with fine breeze from Eastward and passing clouds steered W^NW At 4 p m luff to by the wind headed N Through the night the same Latter part saw the Sch Fanny Byrns and E B Conwell at noon spoke both of the Schs they have not see anything so ends.
