

Monday July 16th All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from N^E and passing clouds headed N^W still cruising saw nothing so ends

Tuesday 17th All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from N^E and cloudy weather headed N^W still cruising saw nothing so ends.

Wednesday 18th All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from N^E and fogg squalls headed to the Northward still cruising saw nothing so ends.

Thursday 19th This day commence with fresh breeze from N^E and cloudy weather headed to the Eastward Middle part wind hauled N^W Latter part the same steered S^E still cruising so ends.

Friday 20th All this twenty four hours fine breeze from N^W and squally weather steered several courses still cruising so ends

Saturday 21st All this twenty four hours fine breeze from Northward and fogg squalls still cruising saw nothing so ends.

Sunday 22^d All this twenty four hours light breeze from N^E and calm headed to the Westward still cruising saw nothing so ends.

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Monday July 23^d All this twenty four hours light air and calm headed N^W still cruising saw nothing so ends

Tuesday 24th All this twenty four hours light air from Eastward and calm headed N^W still cruising repaired the foretop sail so ends.

Wednesday 25th This day commence with light breeze from S^E and calm steered W^N Middle part the same Latter part cloudy At 7 a m saw whales lowered the boats at noon boats all off after whales so ends.

Thursday 26th Commence with light air from Eastward and calm boats off after whales At 7 p m boats came on board unsuccessful had no wind to get on the whales Through the night steered N by E that was the course the whales was going when we last saw them Latter part steered several courses looking for the whales had light breeze saw nothing so ends.

Friday 27th This day commence with light air from Eastward and calm wore ship headed S^E Middle part the same Latter part steered W^N still cruising so ends.
