

Saturday July 28th All this twenty four hours light breeze from SE and calm steered WNW hands Employed in repairing the foresail so ends.

Sunday 29th All this twenty four hours light air from SE and calm saw one steamer and one merchant vessel still cruising so ends

Monday 30th This day commence with light breeze from SE and cloudy weather headed SE by W At 8 p m wind hauled to the Northward Through the night headed NW Latter part the same so ends.

Tuesday 31st This day commence with fine breeze from Northward and passing clouds steered NW At 2 1/2 p m saw the Island of St Miguel Middle part calm Latter part light air so ends.

Wednesday Aug 1st Commence with light breeze from W by NW and passing clouds steered NW At 6 p m wind hauled to the Westward at 10 p m wore ship headed W by NW Through the night the same Latter part light breeze saw Terceira and St Miguel so ends

Thursday 2^d This day commence with light breeze from NNW and cloudy weather headed W Through the night headed NW Latter part headed for Terceira so ends.

Friday Aug 3^d This day commence with light breeze and fair weather cruising off Terceira saw Pico and St George headed NW Middle part the same Latter part pass by South point of Pico headed for South point of Fayal so ends

Saturday 4th All this twenty four hours light air from Eastward and calm off South point of Fayal saw plenty of Grampus so ends.

Sunday 5th This day commence with light air and calm off South point of Fayal Middle part the same Latter part light breeze At 5 a m saw whales going quick inshore they went out of sight in half an hour keep the vessel off and steered for the course we saw the whales last At 11 a m saw the whales again at noon lowered the boats and take the oars and pull for them whales 2 miles of so ends.

Monday Aug 6th This day commence with light air from Northward boats off after whales At 1 1/2 p m Starboard boat got past the L Boat and B Boat chase on after loose whales At 3 p m Capt came on board At 4 got the whale long side wore ship and headed for the other boats was chasing the whales At 7 p m boats came on board Through the night Employed in getting ready to cut the whale in At 5 a m commence cutting so ends.
