

Tuesday Aug 7th This day commence with calm Employed in cutting the whale in At 1 1/2 p.m. got the case across of deck at 4 p.m. started the fore Middle and Latter part Employed in bailing so ends.

Wednesday 8th All this twenty four hours light air from Southward and good weather Employed in bailing Trawl and Pies in night so ends

Thursday 9th This day commence with light air from Southward and calm Employed in bailing Middle part the same At 5 a.m. finish bailing Employed in washing the vessel so ends.

Friday 10th This twenty four hours commence with light breeze from S.W. and fair weather headed W.N.W. Employed in ship duty Middle part the same Latter part pumped the salt water out of ground tier and stow the oil down so ends.

Saturday 11th This day commence with fine breeze from Westward and fair weather headed S.W. 1/2 W. Employed in stowing the oil down at 5 p.m. finish stowing down Middle part wind hauled S.W. headed N.W. Latter part strong breeze headed the same saw two sails so ends.

Sunday Aug 12th This day commence with strong breeze from Westward and passing squalls headed to N.W. were ship headed N.W. by S Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Monday 13th This day commence with fine breeze from N.W. and passing clouds headed W Middle part strong breeze and squally furled the light sails Latter part light breeze from N.N.E. Bk under all sails steered W. so ends

Tuesday 14th This day commence with light breeze from S.E. and good weather steered W. rose new main brace on port side hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Wednesday 15th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Eastward and fair weather steered N.W. hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Thursday 16th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Eastward and calm steered N.W. 1/2 N saw two sails bound to the Eastward so ends.

Friday 17th This day commence with light air from N.E. and good weather headed to the Westward at 6 p.m. spoke Brig Herman Smith from Boston bound to Western Islands leaking bad she has got 150 bbls. all told Middle and Latter part headed to the Westward so ends.
