Monday 20th All this twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and good weather passed a piece of a vessel bottom up still cruising so ends

Tuesday 21st All this twenty four hours light breeze from W S W and fair weather still cruising so ends

Wednesday 22^d This day commence with light breeze from Westward and good weather headed to the Northward At 6 p m saw a whale spouting to windward 4 miles off but did not see it again Middle and Latter part calm still cruising so ends.

Thursday 23^d All this twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and good weather rose new main brace in starboard side still cruising so ends.

Friday 24th This day commence with fine breeze from Westward and good weather spoke Brig V 86 Hull Capt Sylva she was hauling whale so got Tuesday Middle and Latter part weather equally still cruising so ends

Saturday 25th All this twenty four hours light and calm still cruising hands Employed in ship duty so ends

Sunday 25th All this twenty four hours light air and calm still cruising so ends

Monday 27th All this twenty four hours light air and calm still cruising Employed in ship duty so ends.

Tuesday 28th All this twenty four hours calm weather hands Employed in ship duty so ends.

Wednesday 29th All this twenty four hours light air and calm headed to the Eastward hands Employed in ship duty so ends
