Monday Sept 10th This day commence with fine breeze from Westward and fair weather at 6 p.m. spoke Brig V^o H^o Hill Middle and Latter part squally and rainy so ends

Tuesday 11th This day commence with strong breeze from Northward and cloudy weather Middle part light breeze Latter part light air and calm bent the cables and got the anchors off the bow At 2 p.m. came to anchor in Sagal so ends this day with 36 hours to begin the harbour log.

Wednesday 12th All this twenty four hours fine weather Employed in washing the vessel so ends

Thursday 13th All this day fine weather Employed in breaking the oil for send it home so ends

Friday 14th All this day fine weather finish breaking out the oil Employed in setting up shooks and stow the ground tick so ends

Saturday Sept 15th All this twenty four hours light breeze and fine weather finish stowing the ground tier hand Employed in ship duty so ends

Sunday 16th All this twenty four hours light breeze and fine weather so ends

Monday 17th This day commence with strong breeze from S^W and rainy weather so ends

Tuesday 18th All this day fresh S^W wind and cloudy weather send one watch on shore on liberty so ends.

Wednesday 19th All this day fresh breeze from Westward and fair weather the watch came on board the other watch went on shore hands Employed in painting the vessel out side so ends

Thursday 20th This day commence with light breeze and good weather weather the watch came on board the other watch went on shore finish painting and received the provision came from home so ends.
